## Rules / Scoring

- 1 Separate competitions will be run for male / female runners
- 2 Points will awarded based on finishing position: 1st place receives 10, 2nd 9 and so on
- 3 Every runner will receive at least 1 point if finishing the race
- 4 Both 1st or 2nd claim runners can score points (i.e. if you are a registered member of another running club and a member Running Somewhere Else)
- 5 To receive points runners must enter under the Running Somewhere Else Club name
- 6 To receive points runners must compete under their own name  
(if you take someone else's number you must get the name changed)
- 7 To receive points runners must wear official club running colours: A vest with a yellow body, with black, green and red vertical stripes under arms with red logo and black "Running Somewhere Else" logo text on front.
- 8 Runners must complete at least 5 events for their total points to count in the final calculation of championship placings
- 9 Therefore, runners must complete at least 5 events to receive a prize
- 10 The best 8 results from each runner will count towards the final total
- 11 Trophies will be awarded to the overall 1st 2nd and 3rd placed runners at the end of season prize giving (assuming there are 3 runners who have completed 5 races)
- 12 In the event of a tie for points for a prize (i.e. top 3 places), the head-to-head race positions will be used.
