RACE INSTRUCTIONS

Race HQ and Refreshments – Fairford Cricket Club, Park Street, Fairford, GL7 4JJ.

Car Parking – This year car parking is being provided for us by Fairford Town Rugby Club, please follow the signs on arriving in Fairford or see the map overleaf – the car park and changing facilities will be open from 8am, at Leafield Road, Fairford.

Race Number – These can be collected from Race HQ from 9am. Your timing chip is attached to your bib.

The Course – A 10km course set on quiet country roads. There are a few gentle hills and the majority of the route is **NOT** traffic free, so personal listening devices are strictly prohibited for your own safety.

Toilets and Changing – Public toilets are available in the Market Square and portaloos will be available at Race HQ. The changing rooms will be open for those who wish to use these facilities.

The Start – The race starts at 10.30am along Park Street. You will be directed there from the Race HQ in Park Street and final safety information will be provided at the start line.

Finish – The finish will also be along Park Street in the same area as the start. We would request all runners to move away from the finish line and into the Cricket Club grounds once they have completed the race to allow plenty of room for other competitors to complete the race safely.

Drinks Station – There will be a water station at approximately 5k and also at the finish.

Prizes – Prize giving will take place at approx. 12noon at Race HQ.

Results – A link to the full results will be posted on the Running Somewhere Else Website within 24 hours of the race. You will also receive an e-mail with your result from our timers DB Max.

Safety Notice – The course is mainly run on roads which are not traffic free and it is your responsibility to use the roads safely at all times. Please follow any instructions which may be given to you by the course marshals and remember that **personal listening devices are prohibited**. If you do not comply with these requirements you will be disqualified from the race.

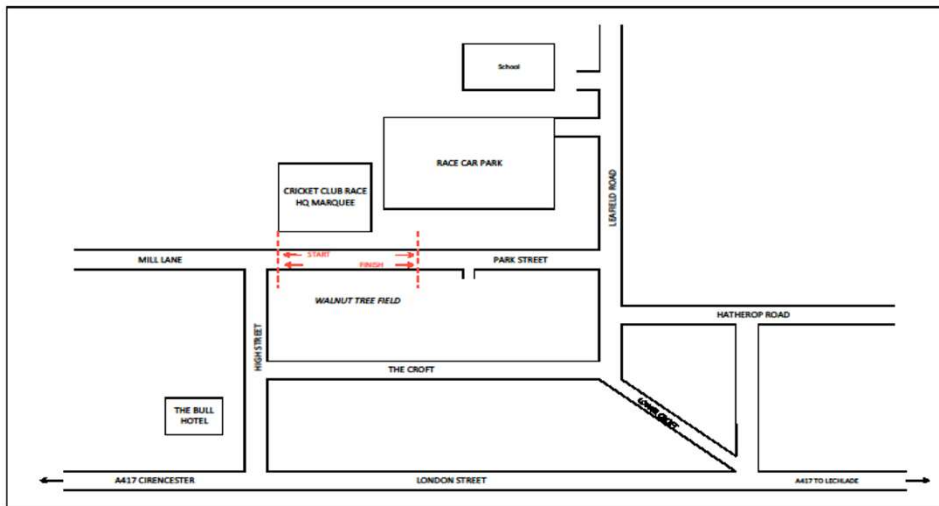

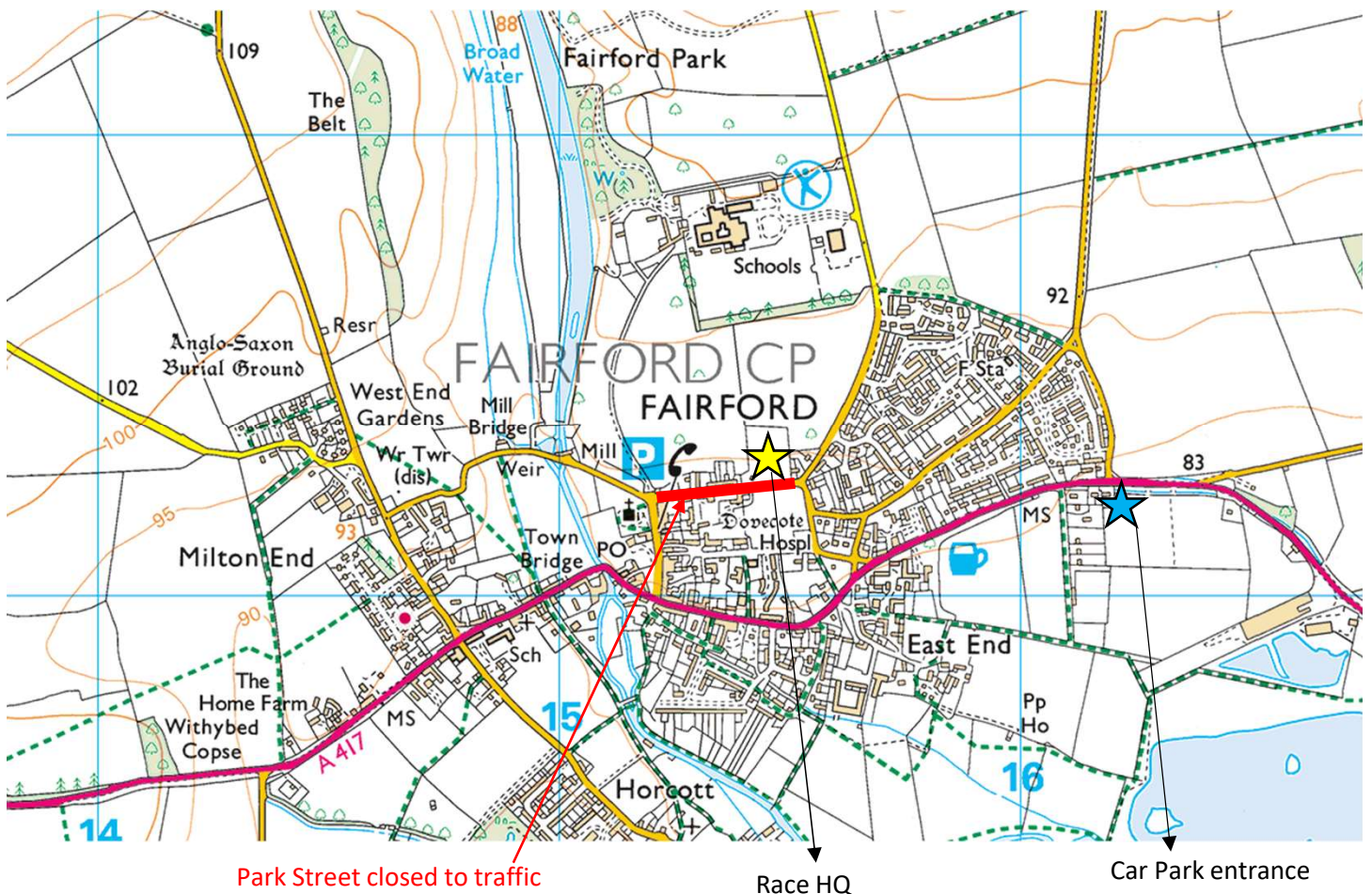
3K Fun Run
